NEW STUDENT ADMISSIONS

Prospective candidates for the Doctoral Program must fulfill the following criteria:

Academic Requirements

- 1. Diploma equivalency letter from the The Directorate General of Higher Education, Research, and Technology (DGHERT) as a substitute for the accreditation certificate.
- 2. Must have achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 on a 4.0 scale in the master's program.
- 3. Must have at least one (1) article published in a national scientific journal or one (1) manuscript ready for submission to a reputable international journal.
- 4. Must provide two (2) recommendation letters from individuals familiar with the applicant's academic capabilities. These may include:
 - Two (2) lecturers from the applicant's master's or undergraduate program (for those without institutional affiliation), or
 - One (1) workplace supervisor and one (1) master's program lecturer.



Administrative Requirements:

- 1. Color scan of passport (personal information page) or other ID.
- 2. Official passport-sized photograph.
- 3. International Health Insurance.
- 4. Dissertation research proposal.
- 5. Certified copies of diplomas and academic transcripts.
- 6. Curriculum vitae (CV).
- 7. Medical certificate issued by a licensed physician.
- 8. For employed applicants, a study permit from their employer.
- 9.A scientific publication manuscript.
- 10.If available, evidence of additional education or training.
- 11.If applicable, proof of participation in scientific activities.
- 12.Statement of financial commitment for the duration of the study.
- 13.Documentation of communication with a prospective supervisor.
- 14.A personal statement of academic and professional goals.
